Make Your Mark - Terms and conditions

Thank you for considering a donation as part of the Make Your Mark campaign by Scotland's Charity Air Ambulance (SCAA), a registered charity in Scotland (Charity No. SC041845). By submitting a name and making a qualifying donation, you accept the terms outlined below.

Make Your Mark campaign

- Make Your Mark is a fundraising campaign that allows supporters who donate the minimum amount outlined below to have their name, or that of a loved one, displayed on the underside of SCAA's new H145 helicopter.
- This campaign is a standalone initiative and begins on 18th August 2025. Any donations made before this date, or not explicitly intended for Make Your Mark, are not eligible.
- SCAA reserves the right to update, suspend, or cancel the campaign, or amend these Terms and Conditions, at any time. Changes will be communicated on the SCAA website.

Name submission guidelines

- Supporters must be 16 or over to submit a name.
- Each donation allows for the inclusion of one name £40 for individuals and £200 for community groups/organisations.
- Supporters may submit multiple names (one per minimum donation amount as detailed above).
- For each donation, supporters will receive a personalised certificate dispatched to the billing address provided during donation.

Name Display Conditions

- Names will be displayed on the underside of the helicopter within a map of Scotland design.
- Alphabetical arrangement by first letter will be used for display and all names will be printed in a uniform font and size.
- Each name:
 - Must include one individual (e.g. "John Smith") for individual donations or one group name ("e.g. Glasgow Volunteer Group")
 - Must be no more than 30 characters, including titles, spaces, and punctuation.
 - May include Formal titles (e.g., Dr., Mr., Lady, Captain)
 - Must not include business names, emojis, special characters (other than hyphens),
 - Must not include offensive/discriminatory content. SCAA may request an alternative if a submitted name is unsuitable for display.

Supporters are responsible for submitting accurate name details. If you
identify an error, email enquiries@scaa.org.uk as soon as possible. SCAA
cannot guarantee changes can be made after submission, but will attempt to
accommodate corrections where feasible.

Decal details

- Each Decal will contain approx. 4000–4500 Names.
- Supporters cannot choose where on the design their chosen name appears.
- The final design and layout of the Decal is at the discretion of SCAA.
- Illustrative drawings are non-contractual and subject to change.

Campaign close and capacity

- The campaign will remain open until all name spaces are filled or SCAA determines to close the campaign.
- Any names submitted after capacity has been reached will be contacted.
 Supporters may choose a refund or to reassign their donation to general funds.
- Names will be printed on the aircraft as soon as reasonably possible after campaign closure, currently expected in early 2026.
- Names will remain on the aircraft for a minimum of 12 months.

Recognition & Ownership

- Submission of a name does not confer any ownership rights to the aircraft or Decal.
- No entitlement to access the aircraft or SCAA facilities is granted through participation.
- Future opportunities to view the helicopter or names in person may arise via public events; attendance is not guaranteed and is subject to availability.

Timings and Delivery

- Campaign closure, installation of names, and delivery of commemorative materials are subject to reasonable delays.
- SCAA is not liable for delays outside of its control.
